The **Lowell's of Hio Ridge** Road are pretty well documented and I have compiled some information here to identify those individuals buried in the cemetery.

There are 25 burials; 9 children; 10 adult males and 6 adult females. The earliest burial is Gideon Lowell (this record in our DHS list is labeled Capt. John). And the most recent burial is Theodore Ingalls Lowell in 1910. He was known as Tiddly I.

There are two Lowell Cemeteries in Oxford County, ours and one in Buckfield. The Lowell's are from the same line from England through Newbury and Amesbury Mass.
