Located on the east side of South Road (Rte. 117), this cemetery is the nearest to the Hiram town line. It is surrounded by the stone slab wall. A 60' x 65' area along the road is vacant, tho enclosed by the wall. The actual cemetery is 60' along road and 100' deep.
